Wedding **Photography and Videography**

at St. Stanislaus Church

Dear Photographer/Videographer,

We welcome you to St. Stanislaus Church as a professional who will partake in the wedding ceremony at the invitation of the bride and groom. Here are some guidelines which we ask you to familiarize yourself with, and abide by, on the day of the wedding.

We have attached two drawings – one is the main floor plan of our church, the other that of the choir loft. You are welcome to stand/move within any of the yellow zones, as long as you:

- a) are not obstructing anyone's view
- b) are not in anybody's way (please note the wedding party will be walking up and down the aisle to their designated places in front beside the bride and groom, as well as to their pews)
- c) are not drawing attention to yourself in any way (please make sure to wear soft/quiet shoes (no high heels) and use quiet camera settings)
- d) are mindful of the sacredness of the place (please note the sanctuary area, including the steps, is off limits; the "gradient fill" yellow zones are "temporary" the two in front only allowed at the very beginning of the ceremony, the one in the main aisle only when everyone's seated and as the married couple leaves the church)


You are welcome to use flash as long as it is not disruptive (not blinding anyone or too loud). Drones are permitted outside of the church only. Our sound system is digital – you are welcome to connect your sound recording device directly to it, having inquired in advance and checked the compatibility.

After the ceremony has ended, the couple usually wishes to take a group photo outside the church on the stairs. Only these are permitted (photo sessions inside the church after the Mass are not allowed). Please note it is your responsibility to guide and direct the couple, their families and guests and to accommodate them on the steps.

All in all, please stay within the yellow zones and be as quiet/"invisible" and respectful of the sacred space as possible.
